UNMISS "Protection of Civilians" (PoC) Sites [i]

• As of 30 June 2016, the estimated number of civilians seeking safety in six Protection of Civilians (PoC) sites located on UNMISS bases is **169,418*** including 93,817 in Bentiu, 32,719 in Malakal, 27,959 in Juba UN House, 2,004 in Bor, 700 in Melut, 219 in Wau and 12,000* in the Wau protected area.
