### UNMISS “Protection of Civilians” (PoC) Sites

As of 14 November 2019, a total of number of civilians seeking safety in six Protection of Civilians (PoC) sites located on UNMISS bases is **190,467 including** 117,767 in Bentiu, 26,359 in Malakal, 29,702 in Juba UN House, 1,943 in Bor, and 14,696 in the area adjacent to UNMISS in Wau “.
