### UNMISS “Protection of Civilians” (PoC) Sites

As of 20 September 2018, a total of number of civilians seeking safety in six Protection of Civilians (PoC) sites located on UNMISS bases is **197,218** including 114,652 in Bentiu, 24,415 in Malakal, 38,215 in Juba UN House, 2,506 in Bor, and 147 in UNMISS base and 17,283 in the area adjacent to UNMISS in Wau “.
